THE BOAT RACE:

Combridge are heavy favourites at the start of the 102nd Boat race - and heavy is right - they can give the Dark Blues half a stone a man. Combridge have the Surrey Station, and take an early lead, hoping to pull amay on the long bend; but Oxford hang grimly on, striking faster than Cambridge in answer to the Light Blues' greater power.

As they come to Hommersmith Bridge, Combridge's lead is up to a length. This is where last year's race was all over bar the shouting, but do-ordie Oxford aren't going to let Cashridge steal a runaway victory this time.

Coming round to Chiswick Steps, the Light Blues creep sheed again to two and a half lengths, but they're fighting a crew that doesn't know when its beaten, At Duke's Meadows, Oxford have out the lead down to one and a half lengths, and it's no greater as they shoot Barnes Bridge. The Dark Blues are hanging on like terrisrs after a rabbit.

Into the final stretch, and Oxford are actually exceping up. Only a length behind near Mortlake Brewery, and fighting every yard of the way!

The groud's mad with excitement as both grews give everything they've get. Here's the finish coming up - Combridge winning in the third fastest time ever - but only a length and a quarter sheed of Oxford, who by sheer courage have made it one of the most thwilling duels in Boat Race history!
