The Barl of Searberough, sits next to Chinese Deputy Premier Ulan Fu. Guests from as far away as Iceland have come to match the crowning of the only Hindu King in the world. The moment of crowning is 10,43,a,m, exactly, chosen by the reyal astrologues as the most amagicious for a peaceful and prosperous reign. Outside the temple, richly apparelled ejephants wait for the reyal procession through the streets of Katmanda.

By tradition, the King of Nepal should be crowned with two Queens, one on each side; for all the fundal magnificence of Nepal, King Mahendra has 20th century ideas. He is the first of his ancient dynasty to refuse to marry twice. And he is the first to admit the world to his mountain kingdom - until now, one of the most mysterious countries of the Orient.
