

POWER EXPERTS IN MOSCOW.

British power experts, headed by Lord Citrine, Chairman of the Central Electricity Authority, are shown round the Moscow Power Institute during their tour of the Soviet Union, and spend some time in the high-tension laboratory. The delegation are in Russia on a return visit following the recent visit to Britain of Georgi Malenkov, the Soviet Minister of Power Stations, who conducts them personally round the Institute.

The management of the Institute give a luncheon in honour of their British guests. At the luncheon, as a souvenir of their visit, Lord Citrine is presented with a bound volume showing the fifty years' history of the Institute.

After the official hospitality, the British experts get an equally friendly send-off from the Institute's students - typical of the Russians' growing desire for contact with the West.
