STORY : OVER 100 KILLED & 12,000 RENDERED HOMELESS

IN EARTH QUAKE IN KUTCH INDIA

LOCATION: ANJAR, BHUJ, KUTCH AREA (WESTERN INDIA)

THE RAN OF KUTCH IS THE BOARDER TERRITORY OF INDIA WHICH IS VERY PROXIMATE WITH THE PAKISTAN TERRITORY OF KARACHI. IN A WORST EVER EARTHQUAKE IN THE AREA MORE THAN 100 PERSONS DIED AND NEARLY 12,000 BECAME HOMELESS OVERNIGHT. MOST OF THE ANJARS POPULATION OF 20,000 WAS INDOORS AS TREMORS ROCKED THE TOWN WOMEN AND CHILDREN RUSHED SCREAMING OUT OF HOMES. MANY HOWEVER WERE TRAPPED WHILE AT DINNER OR AT BED AS 500 OF THE TOWNS 1000 HOUSES, CLOPPASED OVER THEM. THE ROAD BETWEEN ANJAR AND BHUJ WAS PLOUGHED UP IN MANY PLACES HAMMERING SPEEDY ARRIVAL OF RESCUE SQUADS. SINCE THE DESTRUCTION HAS BEEN SPREAD TO SEVERAL MILES, IT IS DIFFICULT TO PRESENT A TRUE PICTURE OF THE GREAT HAVOC.
