STORY: II2 killed in Train Disaster near Hyderabad in India.

One of the worst train disasters took place near Hyderabad in South India on the 2nd September morning when the Benglore bound passenger train from Secunderabad crashed into a small rivulet near JADCHERLA Station about 70 miles from Hyderabad. More than II2 bodies had been recovered but there were many more which were still to be traced either from below the debris or from the water stream.

Though the cause of the accident has yet to be established but the official surmise is that the rivulet was suddenly swoolen by the waters of another tank a couple of miles upstream which bursts its banks.

All the other casualties were from the first two bogies which were smashed to smithereens by their violent impact with the engine which sank into the river as the small ho feet masonary bridge spanning the rivulet collapsed when the train was passing over. All members of the crew were saved.
