LONDON v. BUDAPEST - WHITE CITY.

Top athletes from London and Budapest meet at the White City - and in the very first running event, the men's 100 metres, British sprint champion, John Young suddenly falls headlong on the track! His second mishap against Hungary in 11 days. S. Jakabfy of Budapest takes the lead to win by inches in 10.3 seconds - six points up for Hungary.

Norris, Sando, and Dunkley represent London in the 5,000 metres, against Budapest's Kovacs, Szabo, and Varga. A vital contest - for this meeting, sponsored by the Evening News, is the last pre-Olympic international. Frank Sando leads in the early laps - and meanwhile let's take a look at the hammer event. Someone's thought of a novel way of lighting up.

The winning throw is by J. Csernak of Budapest, the 1952 Olympic champion - 195.ft. 8 ins.

Thelma Hopkins wins the women's high jump - helping to clinch Britain's overall triumph!

Back to the 5,000 metres, where Szabo is leading Norris on the last lap - but Frank Sando has overtaken Ken Norris and is pounding after the Hungarian! The crowd roars with delight - but Szabo's still going strongly - has the Englishman left it too late? No, he hasn't! There's the tape - and Frank Sando snatches victory by a hair's breadth, Whata finish - and what a promise for Melbourne!
