General GRUENTHER's Farewell To SHAFE covered by all competition Positive developed: 195 ft - 58 meters

This morning a coremony marked the farewell official occasion with General Alfred M.GRUENTHER taking his leave from SHAFE and handing over office to his successor General Norstad.

Arriving at 11.50 in SHAPE grounds where troops were already gathered, General Gruenther accompanied by Field Marshall Montgomery, General Morstad, Admiral Sala and General Schuyler walked to the official stand where they stood at attention to take the salute from parading troops.

When the march-pass is over, General Gruenther made his farewell speech before handing over officially his functions to General Norstad who answers the speech. During this official core; ony the SHAPE FLAG is hoisted before the stand and put in place afterwards.
