You'll understand me when I say that it's with a mixture of sorrow and pride that I speak to you as Prime Minister tonight. Sorrow, because my friend and leader has had to lay down his burden because of grievous illness. A man of character and courage. I'm sure there's not one of you in this country who does not join with me tonight in withing him a safe voyage and a speedy restoration to health. And pride, yes pride, on assuming the great office of Prime Minister.

There's an immonse job shead, and we mean to do it. I've plaked my team to get on with the job, and to get results a and to keep on getting results. There's going to be no General Election.

Every now and again since the war I've heard people say "Ism't britain only a second or third class power now? Ism't she on the way out?"

What nonsense. This is a great country and don't let's be ashemed to say so. It has a superb record of achievement of every kind. The country that produced the men who invented the steam engine, gave us penisillin and discovered radar, and the men who first mastered the atom; the country that built the first atomic power station has no reason to quiver before our temporary difficulties. After all, this year that's just passed, we have had all-time record experts and the best savings for years. Anyway, twise in my lifetime I've heard the same old tale about our being a second rate power, and I've lived to see the answer.

It's trusthat in a material sense, population, the termage of steel made, or supplies of metals and raw materials, this island can't match the vast resources either of the UnitedStates or of Russia. All the same Britain isn't along. Think of the Commenwealth and all that this implies. Then there are the peoples of Europe. With these countries, with France perhaps particularly, we already have close ties. I firmly believe it is our destiny to work more and more closely with them. The total of the strength and wealth in all these communities, Commenwealth and Europe, is no less than that of the two giant powers. But of course it's not just material resources that make a nation great. It's character and leadership not only in Government but in industry, in the trade unions, in the home, everywhere.

Interest one more thing to which I must make reference. A
lot of people are worried about our relations with the United States. The
life of the free world depends upon the partnership between us. Any partners
are bound to have their differences now and them. I've always found it so.
But true partnership is based upon respect. We don't intend to part from
the Americans and we don't intend to be satellites. I'm sure they don't want
us to be so. The stronger we are, the better partners we shall be; and I
feel certain that as the months pass we shall draw continually closer together
with the metual confidence and respect.

As for courage and character, I know the British people have these in full measure. All we need is confidence in our country and in ourselves. So don't let's have any more defeatist talk of second class powers and of dreadful things to come. Britain has been great, is great and will stay great, provided we close our ranks and get on with the job.
