

NORMAN HARTNELL'S NEW VENTURE.

On the right - black and orchid pyjamas in double nylon denier; on the left, coatee, and more pirate pyjamas in flame-coloured nylon velvet. And now some more terylene - a Dubarry pleated ninon nightdress on the right, and a rose crepe nightdress on the left, both with attractive bed-jackets; this one in Dubarry, to match the pleated ninon...

And this is star blue, to contrast with the rose-coloured crepe.

This washable housecoat is in flame-coloured nylon velvet, revealing a black nylon marquisette half slip, trimmed with white. A new venture for Norman Hartnell - but a new venture with the touch of an old master!
