Moraine, French Alps

Jean VUARNET yesterday won the giant slalom in the 44th ski championship of France. His time was 1 minute 54.7 seconds.

Charles BOZON winner of the french downhill title, and Gerard PASQUIER tied for the second place in 1:58.6. René COLLET followed, clocked in 1:57.1

Yesterday's victory was the second straight for Vuarnet who won the slalom in Friday's competition.
