PRELIMINARY COVERAGE

ROLL 1. UNDERGROUND

1. Approaching the back of the boring shield
2. G.V.'s of boring shield
3. Workman on control valve of hydraulic system.
4. Reverse (front) of boring shield showing cutting edge. The shield is in position for starting boring the full size tunnel.
5. Workmen putting a drill in position which will demolish the concrete rim before boring begins.
6. Shot along the 12 foot diameter pilot tunnel which stretches to Purfleet.
7. Coming through air lock
8. Compressed air control panel. Engineer on telephone.
9. Descending to base of shaft in hoist.

Roll. 2 SURFACE

1. G.V. of workings and across river to Purfleet
2. Surveyor at work on Dartford side.
3. G.V. Across river to Purfleet.
