EARTHQUAKE IN TURKEY:

Three small towns and a host of villages were stricken by earthquake tremors, intermittently afflicting a large area of south west Anatolia, in Turkey. Though the devastation was mostly confined to less than a minute, minor quakes continued for 48 hours. Early tremors were a warning and thousands of people fled to the fields in time. President Bayar and Premier Menderes satisfied themselves that everything possible was being done in the camps for the homeless.

From Cyprus the British Authorities sent food and clothing. So far as is yet known only sixteen people were killed, a very small number considering the extent of the quake.
