Taxi! I say, taxi! Serry sir, this que's booked - but if you're looking for a car which has been running long enough to prove its worth, there are dosens of them in this Veteran and Vintage Car Rally at Hayling Island. Their ages vary from 29 to 61 years.

The oldest is this 1896 Arnold Noter Carriage. And here's a 1910 Remault Landaulette, followed by a 1906 Unic taxicab. (Traffic's terrible these days, my dear, and by the time you get there, your clothes are already out of date)

The Concours d'Eleganee show that all these old-timers have one thing in common - each one has been lovingly looked after for very many years. Here's a 1928 Humber - and over here a 1902 George Richard-Brazier, quivering and excited, and thirsty.

The judges inspect a 1909 Renemit - There are prises for veteran, Edwardian and vintage ears; first prise in the veteran class goes to Mr. Colver for his 1896 Arnold, And the overall trophy goes to Mr. Skinner's 1910 Rolls, What - only 1910?
