40,000 Boys and Girls-scout celebrate Lord Baden Powell in Belgium Positive **EXPERSES** UNDEVELOPED: 21 meters - 70 ft

All over the world this year 1957 is a year of celebration for youth' boys and girls scouts. They celebrate the hundredth anniversary of the birth of their foundator Lord Eande-Powell, and at the same time the half century of their organisation.

In Belgium this double-anniversary was celebrated by all Boys and Girls scout associations, and for the Baden-Powell Jubilee Day some 40,000 boys and girls arrived in Brussels. After prayers in the morning yesterday, the afternoon was devoted to celebrations in the Stade des Trois Tilleuls, in Boisfort near Brussels.

King Baudouin presided over the giant march-pass of scouts organizations with many officials of the Movement. Lord Peter and Lady Baden-Powell were present to the celebration which included a folkloric danses and songs program.
