1-4 On a record flight -- the U.S. Air Force B-52. Actually six of the Stratofortresses of the Strategic Air Command are making the hop -- and what a hop it is! -- ten-thousand six-hundred miles, non-stop -- from the United States to Buenos Aires and back.

5-9 This latest demonstration of the global striking power of the Air Force sees the giant jet bombers winging to the South American coastline -- over Venezuela, Brazil and Bolivia before arriving to salute Buenos Aires -- making their sweep over the Argentine capital where aeronautical week is being observed.

( 10-SOUND UP OVER B.A. )

11-15 Refueled in flight by jet tanker planes, the fifty-twos fly homeward averaging more than five hundred miles per hour, at altitudes of 40-thousand to 50-thousand feet.

16-19 Described as a "cell of planes" by the Air Force, it marks the first time such a group makes a flight of this type -- less than 24 hours to Buenos Aires and back!
