

JAPANESE MONORAIL:

Tokyo tries out a new way to ease its traffic problems - a monorail train, designed to carry local traffic over streets with a minimum of ground construction. Only an experiment, as yet, in Tokyo's Ueno Park - 366 yards of it, costing \$180,000. Each car is 29 feet long and five feet wide, and the maximum speed, is 25 miles an hour. Tokyo runs neck-and-neck with London for the title of the World's Biggest Town, and it's certainly more congested; something's got to be done - and maybe this is it!
