Sir Edmund Hillary, the modest New Zealand bee-keeper of Everest fame, who became a world here when he and Tensing were the first human beings to stand on the peak of Everest, has added another great vietery to that historic achievement. Hillary had reached the tep of the world - and now he has balanced his record by reaching the <u>bottom</u> of the world - the South Pole.
