

SPEEDBOAT DEATH:

Eric Selva, 56-year-old Italian speedboat star, announces that he is retiring - and that the Orange Bowl regatta at Miami Beach is to be his last race. Our camera watches Selva rearing across Biscayne Bay at 100 miles an hour - and captures the disastrous moment when his words come true.

In a few grim seconds, Selva is fatally injured, before the eyes of the crowd. Crushed by the splintered hull, he is lifted away. A Milan wire manufacturer who loved speedboat racing, Eric Selva won fame at his hobby - but by a tragic irony, he raced just once too often...
