SAHARA OIL DELIVERED TO SEA PORT
Positive developed : 135 meters - 445 28

Last week has been a great week for France. And when the first Sahama odl reached TOUGGOURT through the first pipe-line which brought it across the Sahara from Hassi Messacud 125 miles away, Minister of the Sahara, Mr. Lajeume was present with oil personnalities to witness the event.

The first oil reached Touggourt last week through the sixinch pipe line and the first tank-car shipment was immediately organised to reach the Mediterranean part of Philippeville on Saturday last, for shipment to Prench refineries.

This great event means for France, the begining of the end of her dependence on costly petroleum from the Hiddal East and the Carribbean and the fruition of an enterprise that should tide her industries ever fuel requirements until atomic energy can be harnessed to factories in the country.
