## FLOODS DAMAGE KARIBA DAM:

The circular coffer dam of the Kariba Hydro-Electric scheme is threatened by the swirling, flood-swollen waters of the Zamberi River. Unless the round, consrete structure holds against the hourly increasing pressure of the rising waters, months of delay will add to the construction costs, already estimated at £80m. Faced with Mature on the rampage the engineers could do nothing but wait, and hope for the best.

The circular dan was built in midstream, and then drained of water, so that the foundations of the permanent dan could be made on the river-bed, Scon after these pictures were flown to England the river breached the concrete walls. All on the spot now pray that the flood waters will very scon fall.
