

DUKE WITH LONDON WELSH.

Prince Philip meets the London Welsh Association in the State Apartments of St. James's Palace. One of the guests is Dr. Mashar-ul-Islam, from Pakistan; the 2,000th trainee in Britain under the Colombo Plan; for this is a Commonwealth occasion, too; Lord Ogmore, on behalf of the Welshmen of London, presents a rose bowl for the Festival of Wales, and a cheque for the sixth British Empire and Commonwealth Games - which of course, are being held in Wales. Prince Philip accepts both gifts.
