DE GAULLE/ADENAUER TALES Positive developed : 122 meters - 407 ft

Two great statesman of Burope met for the first time yesterday when West German Chancelor Konrad Adenauer arrived at the home of Premier Charles de Gaulle in Colombey-les-deux Eglises for a private visit and a first interview which gave, in the communique middle issued later in the day, the warmest expression of French-German friendship and cooperation since the end of World War II.

Mr.Adenauer arrived by car in time for a hunch with General de Gaulle and Madame de Gaulle, and the afternoon was devoted to a man to man conversation between General de Gaulle and his guest, only accompanied by interprets. Later in the afternoon German and French Foreign Antanandama Ministers jeined the two Statesman.

Mr. Couve de Murville and Mr. von Brentano French and Gorman Foreign Ministers had also had seperate meetings with their staffs in near-by Chaumont before arriving at Colombey-les-deux-Eglises. It was reported that in Chaumont the two Foreign Ministers had made further progress on agreement of the free-trade some which will come up for discussion at the meeting of the Foreign Ministers of the European Common Market in Venice later this week.
