THE POPE LAID TO MEST:

In silent sorrow Rose's mourning thousands awaited the last return of Pope Pius 12th. To St. Peters, the very wentre of Catholicism, the mortal remains of His Holiness were borne from Castel Gandelfo, the place where he died. The Certege pessed the Colosseum, where pagan emperors martyred early Christians. Reminders of the turbulent ages when popes sometimes called upon armed defenders, marched the noble guard and swiss gward.
