NEW LIFEBOAT CAN'T SINK.

It's guite safe to rook the boat this time, because it's practically impossible to sink it. The plastic lifeboat took Gustav Kuhr seven years to design and make. Exit is easy, one side or the other, however much she may list. Once down the hatsh, the crew and passengers can defy almost any weather. In fact, short of a collision it's difficult to see what could make the boat sink. Closed up, it's like being in a submarine for the ferty people who can be accommodated. The little boat could he sucked down sixty feet by a sinking ship, and still bob up smiling, the engine going, and all set for return to herbour. Placiglans glabes, fore and aft, give a clear view, even when the four hatches are scaled.
