

10.40.a.m.

Trailers leave the main Stamford Road from both ends and proceed to the old bridge.

10.45.a.m.

Trailers at the bridge. After the ceremony please give careful attention to timing, delay or speed up the procession on its journey up to the field in order that you arrive at the field entrance at 11.30.a.m. precise. It is essential that the teams arrive at the field simultaneously, your co-operation to see that this is done is specifically requested.

After arrival at the field the teams will stay on the tractors until they have gone as far as possible towards the brook where on arrival they will dis-embark and line up facing the brook. (the tractors will remain in this position until after "The Queen".).

Mr Miller, Mr Fetch, Mr Campling and Mr Harker will then go on to the bridge, and Mr Cook on the South-Side and Mr Dart on the North-Side will stand at the ends of the bridge.
