

NEHRU MEETS LAMA.

The awe-inspiring Himalayas look down upon Mussoorie, the hill station where the Dalai Lama took refuge, with the consent of the Indian Government. Unused to being at the centre of world-news, the people nevertheless went about their oriental ways until they heard that Mr. Nehru was on his way to visit the Tibetan Ruler. The Premier, here at Mussoorie as throughout India, has increased his popularity by his kindness and courage in granting asylum to the Dalai Lama. On horseback he completed his journey to the house which a prominent Indian industrialist has put at the Exile's disposal.

At Birla House the two men exchanged the traditional scarves of friendship. Mr. Nehru told the Dalai Lama that his safety as an honoured guest in India was assured.
