Given a civic veloome in Salisbury is the Mayor of Durban Commillor Ted Show and to mark the occasion he is presented with an Illuminated Address by the Mayor of Salisbury, Mr. Posselt. Mr. Show is the son of a Rhodesian Pioneer which made his welcome all the more cordial, and in return he presented a stinkwood ten tray to the City Council. During his tour Hr. Show visited the Tobacco Producers Floors where he was warnly received on his arrival. It no doubt occurred to him that Tobacco indirectly benefits his own city, for the sale of tobacco provides the wherewithal for many Rhodesians to spend their holidays in Durben. Getting a first hand view of the Federation's industrial development, the visiting mayor was taken on a tour of Lever Brothers, who of course have a large factory in Durban as well. His itinerery included Kariba. which is now the Federation's prestest tourist attraction, and he tried to capture its and inspiring vastness on film. Progress at Kariba has reached the stage where the conductors which will carry power from the generators on the South Bank to the North, are being stretched across the garge. A thin wire

is winched across, attached to the aluminium covered conductors. Six such conductors will carry the power in 5 phases, each of 330 thousand volts. It's a tricky operation, guided entirely by telephone. On the dan wall itself, the main activity centres on the construction of the road and footpaths which will run along the top. Our old friend the Blondin platform is still doing yeoman service, transporting thousands of tems of commute and dumping it into position. As each load of concrete is dusped, the vibrators are used to drive out the air and consolidate it. In addition to the road and footpaths, provision is being made to house the huge spillway gates which will control the flow at flood levels. In this section the time factor is not so vital. for the lake will still take some years to fill. Meanshile in picturesque cascades the flow passes Keriba, and the tormented furies of a mighty river are things of the past.
