

AUSTRALIAN INGREDIENTS FOR  
SIR WINSTON'S BIRTHDAY CAKE

In readiness for Sir Winston Churchill's 85th birthday on November 30, Madame Maria Floris, the Royal baker, is busy preparing an extra-special cake.

Carefully chosen ingredients from Australia will be included in the cake and today (November 23) Commonwealth representatives called on Madame Floris at her Soho bakery to present them to her.

Mr A H Matthews, UK representative of the Australian Dried Fruits Board brought with him 20-lbs of sultanas; Mr R E Moore (Dairy Produce Board) took eight lbs of the finest Australian butter — and to set the final touch to the cake, Mr Harold Morris (Wine Board) gave a bottle of Australian St Agnes brandy.

The design for the decoration of the cake remains a secret between Madame Floris and Lady Churchill. The secret will be kept until the cake is brought in after the family dinner to celebrate Sir Winston's birthday on November 30.

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
