STEYNLAAN 5 - HILVERSUM (HOLLAND)

DIEB-HURST IN AMSTERDAL -

Today, 14th Jammary at approximately 8 a.m. one of the dykes north-west of Amsterdam, bursted and through a hele of it, about 150 feet water came into polder 8, which is next of the village Tuinderp-O. Saan in the very northern part of Amsterdam.

The water comes from one of the side-canals (canal H) of the North Sea-canal, which is the connection between Amsterdam and Lymniden at the North Sea (temperature mimus 10 degree now).

Within an hour the water rose to 3 feet and now, about 6 hours after the dyke hursted the water has risen to about 5 feet.

Appreximately 400 families have to be evecuated.

The Mavy, Army, Fire-brigade, Red-Cross etc., they all went to the place of disaster and in small rowing-beats and sideseeing boats, people are taken out of their houses, some of them carrying cats and dogs and other "life-possessions".
