

ALGIERS RIOTERS BUILDING UP STRONGHOLD  
35 mm. developed positive: 98 meters = 325 ft

Following the violent outburst in Algiers on Last Sunday european rightist extremists are building up a kind of stronghold in the sector of Algiers they are occupying.

Tuesday afternoon as the previous day, a crowd of europeans, mostly very young boys and girls, came again to chat with the "rebels", but sympathizers who had stayed with them have returned home after a few hours. There are no arabs with the "rebels". The crowd came as for a walk in the sunny weather, listening to the orators who are asking full integration of Algeria into the French Republic, and refusal to follow General de Gaulle's September 16. offer for autodetermination.

Meanwhile paratroopers and police forces have moved around the "rebel stronghold" and are preventing any entries, while letting the outgoing people pass their roadblocks. They are peacefully walking around in their vigil, and friendly chatting over the barricades with the "rebels".

This coverage show views of the sector occupied by the armed extremists, building up barricades and reinforcing their positions with everything they can find, unpaving the streets etc...
