PLANE DOWN ON MOUNTAIN.

Crashed on a summit of the Sierra Nevada lay an American plane, which struck the snow after dark. Resours trudged 7,000 feet up to the spot. They'd been summoned by two of the passengers, the only ones who escaped injury. The aircraft was carrying 24 newal personnel from Neples to Rota, near Cadiz. Now they needed first aid. Fortunately no one was killed, no one seriously hurt. But after a freesing night in the smashed fuselage, the sooner they were taken down the mountain for proper treatment the better. To the snow, which softened the impact when the plane grashed, the passengers probably owe their remarkable escape. Incidentally, they included members of a water pele team, on the way to a match.
