MOSS WINS T. T.

Stirling Moss is back at his brilliant best. He drove the fastest practice lap at Goodwood, so his lucky number seven Ferrari had first place on the line-up for the Le-Mans-type start. It was the 25th R.A.C. Tourists Trophy Race, and it goes to the man who drives the longest distance in three hours. Moss has won two previous TT's at Goodwood. Victory today would give him the coveted hat-trick. He drove against top rate opposition of Aston Martin and, in the lower classes, Lotus and Porsche. That Stirling was back in pre-accident form he showed right from the start. The Goodwood circuit is just a little short of two and a half miles.

Hot on Stirling's heels was Roy Salvadori, driving as Aston Martin.

Number No.10 Innes Ireland, Aston Martin. This year's up and coming star.

At the end Moss had driven 108 laps at 85.58 miles per hour. Congratulations from Lady Carr on his Goodwood hat-trick and sixth T.T. win. What a miraculous recovery after an accident which many thought would end his racing career.
