this famous scottish regiment, who has such famous battles as mysore, cape of good hope (1806), sevastopol and khartoum in their battle honours in addition to practically all the major campaigns of the two world wars, is shortly to return to scotland for amalgamation with the queens own cameron highlanders to form the 1st battalion the queens own highlanders.
