

EASTER MONDAY INTERNATIONAL CAR RACE MEETING

Goodwood Circuit - 3rd. April 1961.

PRESS NOTICE:

General arrangements for this meeting are as follows:

Race Practice: Official scrutineering and practice for all cars is between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturday, April 1st.

Race Programme:

- 1.30 p.m. St. Mary's Trophy for saloon cars.
- 2.05 p.m. Lavant Cup for Inter-Continental racing cars - distance 50 miles.
- 3.02 p.m. Chichester Cup for Formula Junior racing cars - distance 24 miles.
- 3.37 p.m. Goodwood International "100" Grand Prix Trial Race for Formula I racing cars - distance 100 miles.
- 5.15 p.m. Sussex Trophy for unlimited sports cars (Le Mans type start) - distance 36 miles
- 6.00 p.m. Fordwater Trophy for Grand Touring cars - distance 24 miles.

Press Facilities & Information:

Full Press information services will be available on both Practice and Race day. Practice times, race results and general race information will be posted in the Press Room by the Race Control offices in the Paddock. Only Press Badges dated April 3rd, 1961 are valid for the Meeting. These admit to the Press Stand, the Competitors' Paddock Enclosure, and all public enclosures, but do NOT admit to the track.

Photographers & Newsreel Operators:

Accredited still and ciné operators are issued with "Photographer" or "Camera" armllets dated 3rd. April, 1961, which should be worn on a prominent position round the arm. Both types of armllet admit to all parts of the track, but the holders are asked to keep clear of the actual road; not to distract drivers; and not to interfere with the work of race officials. These simple rules are essential to overall race safety.

Newsreel vehicles must be in position 5 minutes before the start of each race; must not move during a race; and must travel in a clockwise direction round the circuit. The Chief Marshal will be available at the start line to advise newsreel crews if they are in doubt about camera positions. Staging erected just past the Start line and at Paddock Bend is primarily for the use of newsreel operators.
