

U.S. TROOPS IN THE CONGO.

Failure by Katanga President Tshombe to rid his forces of foreign officers, at the request of the Congo UN command, results in fighting, with the UN troops taking control of Elizabethville, the capital. UN troops dot the city at strategic points to maintain control, but sporadic fighting in other parts of Katanga continue. Delegates at the UN are awaiting a full report from Secretary General Hammamrakjold who is at the scene, before expressing opinions on the sudden seizure of Katanga.
