Roll. 1. Story is covered at the Annual Conference of Chief Fire Officers Association and the Institute of Fire Engineers in Edinburgh. The Particular Fire Appliance being featured, an advance on the existing fire ladder escape, is the first in the world outside of U.S.A. Accompanying booklet gives details.		
Sequence. 1. A number of shots of foam extinguishers in use.		
Shot of man waving from window high up in building.		
Shots from platform of appliance as it is raised and N.S. of man to be rescued.		
Shots from platform as appliance is lowering, these to cut in with the following ground level shots of appliance rising, taking off man and coming to the ground.		
Final show of appliance driving on road ( actually descending the Mound to Princes Street).		
Note: The quality of all this is doubtful owing to the filming having to wait until all other demonstrations were completed which with the failing light and the enclosed courtyard of the locale gave lousy conditions.		
Was there anything unusual about the story? If you were assessing it editorially, what would you say?
