✓ THE WALL OF SHAME

The east Berlin Vopo are evacuating inhabitants along the dividing wall. A No-Man's Land is being deliberately made in the German metropolis to render all human contacts between east and west Berliners impossible. More than 2,000 Berliners have been forcefully evacuated.

Now the garden-area belonging to the Reinickendorf district in north Berlin is being ruthlessly destructed.

Dredgers and bulldozers are busy doing this futile, destructive work in 18 hours' shifts. Two workmen took the occasion to escape westwards. The No-Man's Land in Berlin is to be 100 metres broad and will extend right through the city.
