Outside a fashionable Greek Orthodox church in Paris the Marquess of Blandford, son of the Duke of Marlborough. He
and a host of photographers are awaiting his bride, Tina
Livenos, arriving for one of the most talked-about weddings of
the year.

Tina's father, Greek shipping millionaire Stavros
Livanos, leads her to the altar. Legally, she is already Lord
