

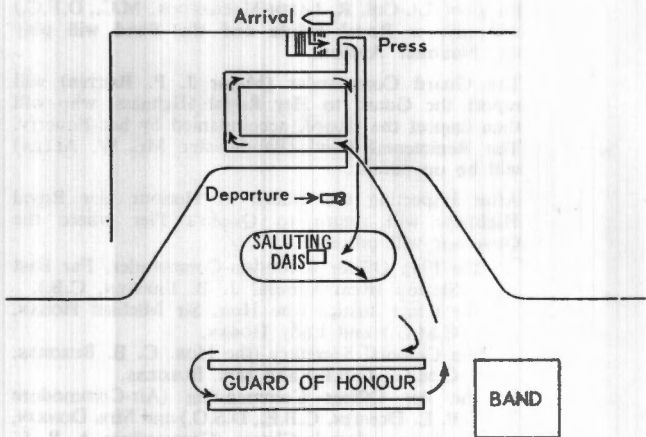

- 4 p.m. Her Royal Highness will arrive at Hong Kong Airport* where she will be received by the Governor (His Excellency Sir Robert BLACK, K.C.M.G., O.B.E.). The Governor will present:

- The Governor will conduct Her Royal Highness to the Governor's Room, where he will present the Director of Civil Aviation (Mr. M. J. MUSPRATT-WILLIAMS) and the Airport Commandant (Mr. O. F. HAMILTON, M.B.E.).
- Her Royal Highness will be invited to sign the Visitors' Book.
- 4.05 p.m. Her Royal Highness will board the Governor's launch.
- As the launch passes through the harbour, a twenty-one-gun salute will be fired by H.M. Ships and the Saluting Battery, 34 Light Anti-Aircraft Regiment, Royal Artillery.
- 4.40 p.m. Her Royal Highness will disembark at Queen's Pier (plan on facing page).

The Commander British Forces will conduct Her Royal Highness to the saluting dais.

The Guard of Honour of 1 Royal Northumberland Fusiliers (Lt.-Col. R. LEITH-MACGREGOR, M.C., D.F.C.) will give a Royal Salute and the Band will play the National Anthem.

The Guard Commander (Major J. P. BAXTER) will report the Guard to Her Royal Highness, who will then inspect the Guard, accompanied by her Equerry. The Regimental Band (Bandmaster Mr. W. ALLEN) will be on parade.
