

WORST DUTCH TRAIN CRASH.

The whole Dutch nation is shocked by the terrible railway disaster at Harmelen, near Utrecht. 87 people were killed; more than 60 injured. An express to Rotterdam, travelling at 75 miles an hour in fog, ploughed into another train, going at forty. The total number of passengers was 500.

1,000 railway men and soldiers helped in the grim work of rescue. This was far and away the most terrible accident in the history of Dutch Railways.

Queen Juliana and Prince Bernhard telegraphed profound sympathy with relatives of the victims.
