

BOMBER SETS NON-STOP MARK

An eight engine jet bomber demonstrates its ability to deliver a long range nuclear punch. The B-524 makes a dramatic assault on the non-stop record for un-refueled flight - held through the last fifteen years of the jet age by a propeller-driven Navy plane. Leaving Okinawa, the U.S. bomber flies over Tokyo and, setting new speed and course marks en route, roars from Seattle to Fort Worth; then, northward to Washington, D.C. and the Azores; finally, to the air base near Madrid, Spain. A record-smashing twelve thousand five hundred nineteen miles, without refueling!
