SPORTS CAR RACING ON ICE

MOTORSPORTS CLUB OF OTTAWA ICE RACING ON BEAUTIFUL LAKE ST. PIERRE DE WAKEFIELD

St. Pierre de Wakefield, Quebec, Jan. 28th, 1962

City workers have found a new way of enjoying their week ends by driving their ordinary cars in various types of races on an ice track.

At beautiful St. Pierre de Wakefield, a peaceful centre in the Gatineau Valley about 25 miles north of Ottawa, these enthusiasts get away from it all for a pleasant week em. The Club holds various ice races and time trials throughout the winter, with rules and regulations which permit of traction being obtained only by rubber-to-ice contact: chains, spikes, wire or any other form is prohibited. Participants using open cars are encouraged to wear helmets, but many of the more daring don't. Women also take part in this sport -- some as drivers, others as navigators. Speeds up to seventy miles per hour are possible on ice depending upon the weather conditions.

A zeep-plough clears an area of about 30' wide for the track. The track circumvents Lake St. Pierre de Wakefield, circles around Nun's Island, and back to the starting point in front of the Hotel Sur le Lac. There is an adjoining lake and plans are under way to make the race more exciting next year by extending the track -- ploughing through a piece of land which includes a hill between the two lakes and then circumventing the second lake also. For protection, bales of hay are used around the track at the start and finish line -- the hotel area.

Because of the slipping on ice, spectators are requested to watch the races in comfort from the Hotel Sur le Lac -- a pleasant place to spend the week end. The majority of races are 5 laps in length; with the Grand Prix, which begins on a La Manns start, being 10 laps. Dash plaques and trophies are awarded to the winners. Ice conditions and the below zero weather combined to make the three week-end meets in January a great success. This is a relatively safe sport despite the sliding.

After the races, spectators and participants enjoy themselves running around on motorized ski scooters, and many of the local car owners have a go with their cars over the track. Next year, it is hoped to have go cart races also.
