

MOON CAPSULE

The spacecraft that will land man on the moon in Project Apollo, is revealed for the first time, in a mock up at Downey, California. Not one but three astronauts occupy the capsule's command module, as this is called. Two other modules house service equipment and lunar landing gear. Food will be taken from tubes, as John Glenn did; but the men will not be so confined as he was. They will move about their compartment manning the complex controls. If development of the craft that can be guided to the moon, landed and relaunched goes on schedule, and sufficient power -- perhaps nuclear -- generated for it, men could emerge like this on the surface of the moon by 1968.
