## THE WORLD'S HIGHEST TRAVELLING TOWER CRANE.

Cranes are seldom in the news unless they class as extraordinary:


On Friday, 6th April, at 11.30 a.m. we hope you will come to a Press Reception at the Tersons Site, Maida Vale, next to the underground station, when you will see the highest travelling crane in the world.

The crane, used by Tersons Ltd., to build three 18-storey blocks, is 207ft. high, weighs 60 tons, and travels on a rail-track 450ft. long, lifting, at times, weights of up to 10 tons.

The crane, manufactured by a French Company, will be fully demonstrated and arrangements for film and photographic facilities are being made.
