St. Clement Danes, blitsed in the war but rebuilt in its old form, has been a household word with children for centuries. Oranges and Lemons the bells of St. Clement; we all sing it in our young days. R.A.F. Chaplain Goodrich and the Reverend Tom Ryder gave an orange and a lemon to each of 300 children from St. Clement Danes School nearby. Why an R.A.F. chaplain? Because the famous church was dedicated as the Royal Air Force church when it was rebuilt.

It's pleasant to see this custom of old time London revived; particularly pleasant to the children.
