At the Goldsmiths' Hall Mrs. Mirabel Topham, owner of Aintree Race course, congratulated prizewinners in this year's Topham Trophy competition. Winning designs of 12 previous years were on view. It was in 1950 that artists were first invited to design a trophy to go to the winner of the race called the Topham Trophy. The competition has been continued every year since.
