U. S. RESUMES NUCLEAR TESTING

Near the isolated Pacific atoll of Christmas Island -- where Britain exploded its first H-Bomb -- the U.S. resumes nuclear testing in the atmosphere. It is the beginning of a test series which will include the firing from a submerged nuclear submarine of the Polaris missile in a proof-test of its warhead. Elsewhere, nuclear devices will be launched by rockets ... and the Minuteman, Atlas and Titan missiles also will be tested. The series is begun with reluctance and regret after fruitless efforts to get Russia to accept a cheat-proof nuclear test ban. In Washington, there is endorsement of President Kennedy's order to resume nuclear testing. Senator Henry Jackson declares.....
