767 ✓ A quick visit to Eglin Air Force Base in Florida gives President Kennedy an eyeful of America's aerial fighting strength. He watches manned weapon maneuvers with General Curtis LeMay and others, including Vice President Johnson and Air Secretary Zuckert. This is the largest of U.S. Air Force Bases, and it's equipped to put on quite a show. Refueling in mid-air extends the jets' already wide range of operation. From reviewing stand the Commander-in-Chief sees a drone plane tracked down and destroyed by fighters. As useful as guided missiles are, the Air Force still puts faith in the combination of intelligence and technology that controlled weapons afford.
