## THE TURKISH EARTHQUAKE.

Turkey lies stricken with almost indescribable horror and tragedy... one of the worst earthquakes in history. Nearly thirty thousand were killed... a hundred thousand injured...and two million made homeless. As Turkey's president Inonu comes to take personal charge of the rescue work... he learns that Turkey has suffered greater loss in a few moments, than all the powers on both sides of the western front... in four months of war of war. S now and almost arctic cold add to the horrors of those who have lost all they had in the world. Volunteers work without rest to bring out the living. There is little hope of recovering the dead. Yet such is the horror of the snow covered aftermath, that perhaps death is more merciful than suffering.

Emergency hospitals overflow with injured, pitiful victims, crushed, they lie in the shadow of death. Searching among the ruins are other victims, stunned parents looking for the bodies of their children. Many have gone raving mad.

The heart of all the world goes out to Turkey and her stricken people... the millions homeless in the snow.
