AMERICAN SHIPS FOR NORWAY.

American ships may no longer sail to Northern Ports under the U.S. Neutrality law so eight of her best merchantmen are being sold to Norway. Now... under the Norwegian flag, there will be nothing to stop them carrying materials of war from U.S. to the Allies.

A few American's say that the sale of the ships to a Foreign country is unneutral. But the vast mass of American public opinion doesn't agree. If the U.S. Flag may no longer fly in British Ports here is one way in which her ships may still serve the Allied cause.
